Thoughts

Pike & Joyce Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc If you don't believe sauvvy blanc is any good 6 months after release read no further! Snow pea and passionfruit are the key elements in this wine. Neil Pike (winemaker) reckons it looks better than when it was released. I didn't have it as a youngster but can happily say it looks as fresh as many 08 releases. Because the market demands the current vintage so strongly, it can be had for \$14 - a steal ... screwcap

Tim Adams Riesling 2007 is back in the shed. This edition is all vibrant fruit- with lemon and lime on offer, great length and acidity. Enjoyable right now, this will also get better if you can keep your hands off it for a year or 3. Seriously delicious ... screwcap

Sorby Adams Eden Valley Sauvignon Blanc Another older sb, this time crafted by Simon Adams, brother of Tim and former Cellarmasters winemaker. Like the Pikes this is very fresh, textural and complex and is discounted because the market is so attuned to drinking current vintage sb's. Like the Pikes this is very fresh and sealed under screwcap.

Pikes Reserve Riesling is from the 2001 vintage. Neil Pike rates this amongst the best Rieslings he has ever made. It's drinking beautifully now, showing soft acid, lots of caramelized lime and good length ... cork

Possums McLaren Vale Viognier has picked up a Trophy at the McLaren Vale win show. It's succulent without being too oily and has lots of lovely stone fruit flavours and creaminess ... screwcap

Sorby Adams WA Semillon Sauvignon Blanc is made from fruit from my old stomping ground - Pemberton/Manjimup WA. This is top cool climate territory and the wine is fragrant, herbaceous, light and yet intense. The winemaker is Simon Adams, former Cellarmasters winemaker, and brother of Tim Adams ... screwcap

Bird in Hand Sparkling is fast achieving cult status, and with good reason. The wine is soft, creamy and strawberry laden, with excellent length and beautiful balance ... cork

Mountadam Eden Valley Chardonnay is a ripper. Recently awarded 94/100 by Halliday this is a balanced and intense wine- not flogged by chunky splinters- rather, supported by the beautiful, delicate French oak. Intense stonefruit and a slice of grapefruit here ... screwcap.

Pertaringa Scarecrow Sauvignon Blanc is the best example of this wine to date thanks to the cool and dry conditions during critical parts of the ripening period. Acid is crisp and mouth watering and there are loads of grassy characters along with a beautifully intense passion fruit zing ... screwcap

Bird in Hand 2 in the bush Chardonnay is a fine and delicate example, showing very little oak. Length and intensity are good - this wine is also very friendly to the ABC (anything but Chardonnay) crew, because it's vibrant and fresh, offering stonefruit characters and just a faint touch of quality French oak ... screwcap

Bird in Hand Rose has been generating a reputation as a faultless serve, thanks in part for being selected twice for service at Wimbledon. Pinot and rose are always a good match, the sour cherry and strawberry of the pinot matching well with this lighter sweeter style. This edition has good acidity and vibrant fruit and the measured dose of sugar is the perfect aid to the fruit, more pushup bra than corset ... screwcap

Leconfield Cabernet just scored the Best Cab award at the recent Hyatt wine awards. It's typical Leconfield Coonawarra- long, fine and intense whipped into shape by cedary oak and finishing with fine, drying tannins. Will reward cellaring ... screwcap

Gemtree Bloodstone Shiraz Viognier This is the best example yet, full bodied, yet feminine, with mouthwatering black and blue fruits on the palate and plenty of length ... screwcap

Gemtree Tadpole Shiraz 2006 Gemtree Tadpole shiraz is the 5th installment of Shiraz from Gemtree and the least expensive- but this isn't the tadpole that must become a frog before it can be transformed into a prince. Rather, it's purpose built and a beautiful thing in its own right. The quality of fruit available to Gemtree and the fastidious winemaking shows through. This is a serious, linear wine with excellent yet taut fruit and great length. Can be enjoyed now (but breathe it first) or cellared for 5+ years ... screwcap

Mak Coonawarra Red It's pretty unusual to find a good Coonawarra red for \$10, but here it is, with all the cellaring already done. Made by Ben Riggs, this wine is Cab dominant with some lovely flavours and good complexity ... cork

Gemtree Uncut Shiraz This vintage, the 07 is a ripper. Yields were substantially down and the resulting wine is super concentrated, thick and complex. It's hard to resist right now but will improve for 10+ years if cared for ... screwcap

Mountadam Barossa Shiraz This wine has a dark red colour with faint purple tinges. The primary aromas are of ripe cherry and white pepper with the intensity of blackberry and rich plum fruit characters. Hints of liquorice and tobacco carry through onto the palate which is complemented with the dark fruit flavours and firm tannin ... screwcap

Rainmaker Grenache Shiraz Made at Read Heads Studio in McLaren Vale. Only 150 Doz of this wine was made- half of which was sold straight into the US. Read Heads has developed a cult like status for turning out loads of cutting edge, small batch wines from excellent fruit ... cork

Banrock Station Petit Verdot is a meat eaters wine. This particular bottling is big brawny and brutal, black and tannic. On it's own it is too big I think but this is a great wine to drink with a big lump of T-Bone. The meat and big tannins work very nicely together ... cork

Turners Crossing Shiraz Viognier is a 95/100 Halliday wine from Bendigo. It has that classic central Victorian ripe but tight thing going on and will cellar brilliantly. Now it's just plain bloody good, with ripe and succulent fruit, including black cherry and plum, minerality, fine tannins and awesome length ... cork

Coriole Contour 4 Sangiovese Shiraz Unfortunately very limited, this beastly is complex, ripe and wonderful. Lots of ripe slippery shiraz characters and savoury peppery sangiovese seasoned with cedary oak ... screwcap

Tim Adams Shiraz The 2004 vintage this time, a little fuller bodied and more complex than the 03 and very easy to drink. Definitely not on the nose, it is one of those wines you can have an each way bet on - drink now or cellar for a handful more years ... screwcap

Dog Ridge the Pup Cabernet Shiraz This is the last of it unfortunately. This wine is in the top 10 best value for money wines we have ever offered ... screwcap

Tyrrells Reserve McLaren Vale Shiraz is normally an export jobby, going for \$20-25 US. It's in a happy place at the mo, showing young and maturing fruit characters, with soft and ripe fruit and good tannins. Good with a quality barbie or roast ... screwcap

Hardy's VR Merlot is an easy drinking, full fruited number offering plum and mocha on the pallet. Perfect with pizza, pasta and as a piñata stuffer. Well maybe not the last bit ... syn cork

Kingston Empiric Durif is black and blue, coincidentally the same colours it'll leave your palate after a glass or 2. This one has a nice balance of fresh and mature characters and is worth decanting before you drink ... cork

Black Chook Shiraz Viognier offers lovely black and blue fruit and a nice bit of blossom and apricot. A strong and feminine style, delicious on its own or any kind of meaty concoction you can think of ... screwcap
